

## CVOA Constitution or Bylaw Proposal #5

Old – Constitution – Article X – Discipline of Members

### Section 2 - Due Process

- 1) An allegation against an official shall be in writing, signed and dated by the complainant, and submitted to the Executive Committee. The charged official will be notified within ten (10) calendar days of the Executive Committee's consideration of the complaint. The official will have the option of responding within 7 calendar days in person at a hearing and/or submits his or her written rebuttal to the Executive Committee. The official involved and the complainant will be notified within ten (10) calendar days of the Executive Committee's final decision.

New – Constitution – Article X – Discipline of Members

### Section 2 - Due Process

- 1) An allegation against an official shall be in writing, signed and dated by the complainant, and submitted to the Executive Committee. The charged official will be notified within ten (10) calendar days of the Executive Committee's consideration of the complaint. The official will have the option of responding within 7 calendar days in person at a **site to be determined**, and/or submits his or her written rebuttal to the Executive Committee. The official involved and the complainant will be notified within ten (10) calendar days of the Executive Committee's final decision.
