- Assigned officials to Metro League one year
- Officiated 5A Regional Tournaments 30+ years
- Officiated 2 State Tournaments

CO High School Boys' Volleyball Association (CBHSVA)

(the precursor to Colorado High School Activities Association (CHSAA) Boys Volleyball)

- Was primary manager of CHSBVA
- Treasurer for 12 Years:
 - Sent email and texts for Registration of teams. Received Team Registration forms, rosters, and fees.
 - Deposited fees. Issued all checks – payments for gym rental, insurance, officiating fees, and any other invoices due.
 - Prepared annual tax returns.

- Assigned officials to referee matches in the Denver Metro Area for 12 years. (Jack West also assigned officials in Denver, as did Nancy Holm in CO Springs)
